2-4 Players

- Write each vocabulary word on an index card or a slip of paper.
- Place all the words into a cup or basket.
- The first player takes a card. He or she must draw pictures to give the other players clues about the word.
- The artist may not speak at all while drawing.
- Pictures may not include letters or numbers.
- The first player to guess the word keeps the card.
- Play continues through all the players until all words have been drawn.
- The player who has collected the most word cards wins!



2 Players

- Write each vocabulary word on an index card.
- Shuffle the cards, and place them face down in a stack.
- Each player picks up one card from the stack and holds it to his/her forehead facing out.
- Players take turns giving one clue at a time about their partner's word without saying the word.
- Play as follows:
 - Player 1 gives one clue about player 2's word, and player 2 tries to name the word. If the player is correct, he/she keeps the card and draws a new one from the deck.
 - Player 2 gives one clue about player 1's word, and player 1 tries to name the word. If the player is correct, he/she keeps the card and draws a new one from the deck.
- The object of the game is to collect the most cards by naming the words correctly.

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
